OUR HISTORY

The Delany Foundation is a registered not-forprofit charity, established in 2008 as a legacy of the Bicentenary of the Patrician Brothers, and named after their founder, Bishop Daniel Delany. Delany saw a need to educate poor Irish children denied schooling, since the 17th century. The Patrician ministry subsequently spread to Australia, U.S.A., Kenya, India, Papua New Guinea, and Ghana.

OUR VISION

- We seek to improve the human and spiritual condition of young people in need.
- We believe that education brings a sense of meaning and purpose to the poor.
- We fund Patrician-linked projects in circumstances of great need in India, Kenya, Ghana, Papua New Guinea, and Australia.

OUR OBJECTIVES

- To continue support for the Kenyan mission of education, medical clinic and mobile dispensary at Kabongo.
- To provide schooling, food and healthcare for children in Ghana.
- To shelter aged and homeless in Conoor, India
- To kick-start enterprises for street youth in Nairobi slums.

 To provide a constant reservoir of water for the Patrician community and its mission at Aitape in Papua New Guinea. - DEL FOUND

 To support the most needy youth in our Australian Catholic schools.

- All Saints College Liverpool (formerly Patrician Brothers' High School Liverpool).

The hope is to broaden the base of funding to include members of the wider Patrician family and their connections. Our Foundation is successfully changing lives. We do this by providing people with opportunity and choice where there is no State or Government funding available for the local communities, in the areas of Education, Healthcare, Pastoral Ministry, or supply of the basics of food and water.
