

ALUMNI PRIVACY POLICY - DELANY FOUNDATION

This Notice is provided to you by the Delany Foundation (ABN 25 839 801 852 - Australian Registered Charity). This Notice sets out the reasons for collecting information about former students and how the foundation will use the information. The Delany Foundation will use personal information it collects for the primary purpose of collection, and for the primary purpose as reasonably expected by the individual to whom they have consented.

The Delany Foundation are required to respect the confidentiality of ex-students and the privacy of individuals. The Delany Foundation has steps in place to protect the personal information held from misuse, interference, loss, unauthorised access, modification or disclosure. These include password protected access to computerised records.

Please note:

1. Graduates each year can choose to opt into the database.
2. The primary purpose of collecting this information is to enable us to contact former students and inform them about the activities of their former School, and the Delany Foundation.
3. We will collect and disclose this information in accordance with standard privacy policies aligned with the Privacy Act 1988. If you provide the Delany Foundation with the contact details of third parties, we encourage you to advise those third parties that you have disclosed their contact details to the Foundation.
4. The Foundation may engage in fundraising and marketing activities. From time to time, we may contact you about fundraising and marketing activities. We may disclose personal information to organisations that assist in the Foundation's fundraising and marketing activities for that purpose. We will not disclose your personal information to third parties for their own marketing purposes without your consent.
5. If you choose not to provide your personal information, you will not be able to receive alumni news and alumni related communications from The Delany Foundation.
6. The Delany Foundation may use online or cloud service providers to store personal information and to provide services that involve the use of personal information, such as email services.
7. You may seek access to and correction of personal information about you, which The Delany Foundation has collected and holds. However, there may be occasions when access is denied. This may occur where the release of the personal information would have an unreasonable impact on the privacy of others.
